Figs. ①~⑤ enable you to make a crane like this with a piece of paper the size of the one below.



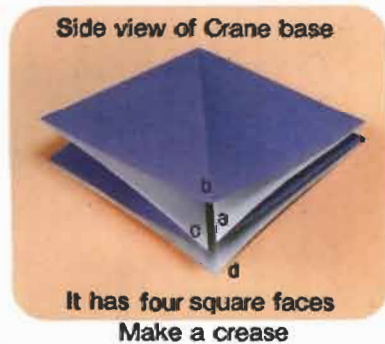
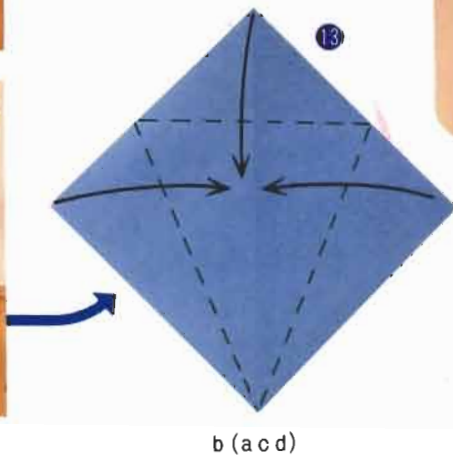
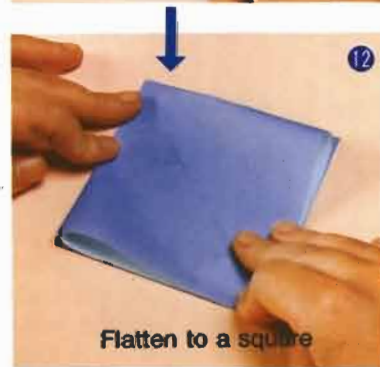
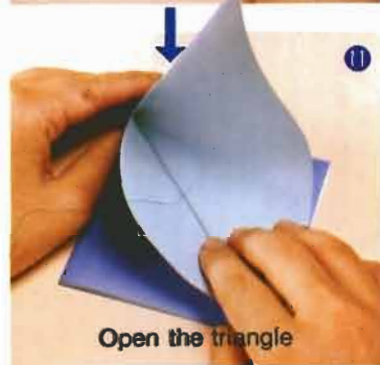
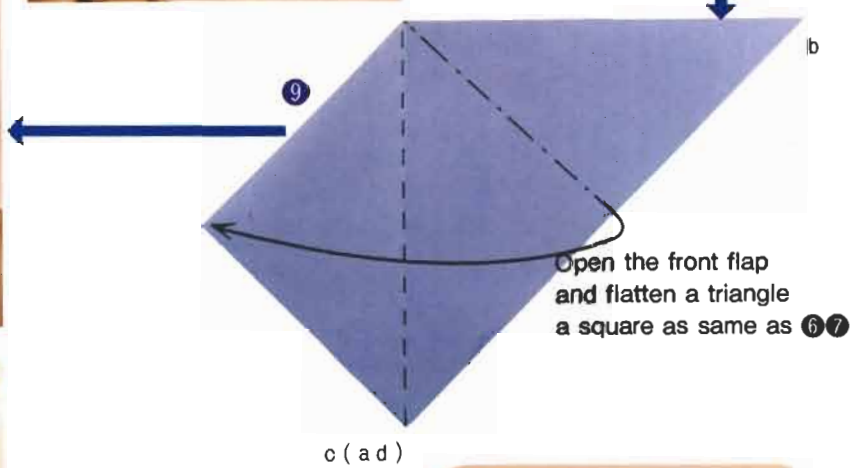
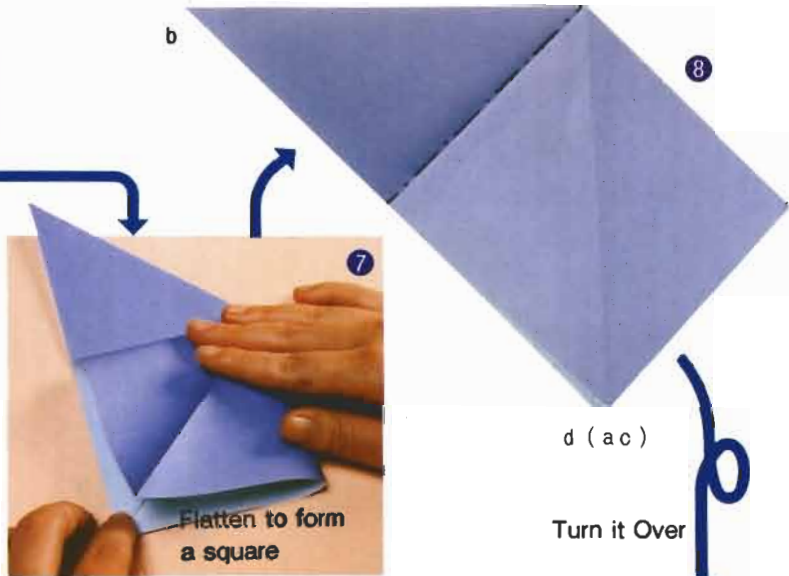
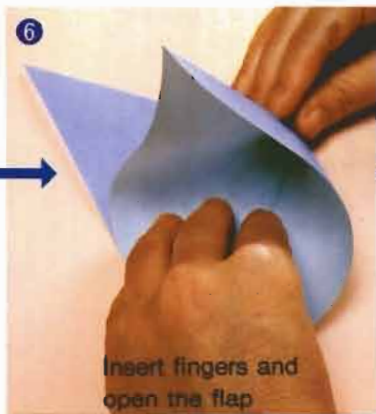

The simplicity and elegance of the crane makes it an especially fascinating figure. It is perhaps the most popular of all the traditional origami folds.

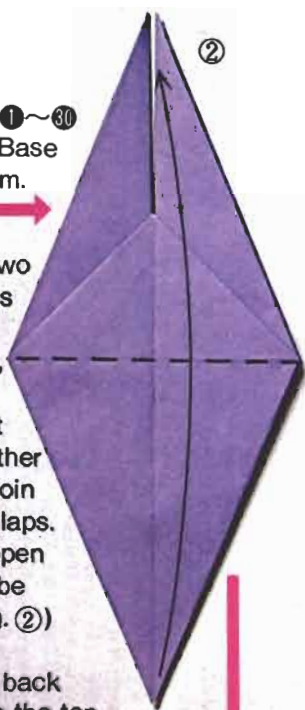
